Welcome to the 19th annual Grand Olde West Days celebration in Craig, Colorado! We are once again planning for live music, street entertainers, arts & crafts, food, contests and activities for the whole family. **The Monday Street Festival** is the finale of our Grand Olde West celebration and is held in the 400 and 500 blocks of Yampa Avenue downtown from 9am to 5pm. Saturday and Sunday are available at the Moffat County Fairgrounds during the Chamber Carnival to round out this great weekend of fun and food.

COST Per booth is \$90.00 for Monday. All three days (Sat/Sun- at Fairgrounds; Monday-downtown) for \$240.00. Booth size is 10'x 20' space and is assigned by the Grand Olde West Days food vendor director. Spaces are assigned on a first enter, first serve basis. **All vendors are required to be downtown on Monday for the street fest. (Limited electricity is available for an additional \$10 per day fee and is only 110v.)**

DEADLINE for application is Sat. May 16, 2009. Approval will be within 5 days of receipt of application. Checks will be deposited upon of acceptance. We reserve the right to accept or reject any application or remove any product not appropriate to the festival. Only a limited number of vendors of each food type will be accepted.

On Monday vendors may begin setting up at 7 am and must remain open until 5 p.m.. After unloading, all vehicles must be removed from the street by 8 am. **Booths must be completely removed from any street locations by 5:55 p.m. on Monday** for highway reopening.

Check-in and setup at the Fairgrounds will begin at 9am Saturday. (The Carnival hours are 11am-11pm on those days.) Booth space is not transferable without permission of Show Directors. Each exhibitor must provide his or her own setup, displays and weather protection. **This is an outdoor event. No refunds will be given due to weather.** Grand Olde West Days Committee is not responsible for theft, damage, or loss.

Vendor is responsible for collecting and remitting sales taxes directly to the Colorado Department of Revenue. A Colorado Sales tax license must be displayed in each booth.
